Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2023, NIH funded awards totaling \$386 million in Alabama, supporting 4,769 jobs and \$909 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2023, the biopharmaceutical industry in Alabama supported 12,786 jobs and 1,235 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Alabama³

- In 2024, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 30,270 will reside in Alabama.
- In 2024, an estimated 611,720 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 10,600 residents of Alabama.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.22 billion for the NIH in FY 2025.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
