### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

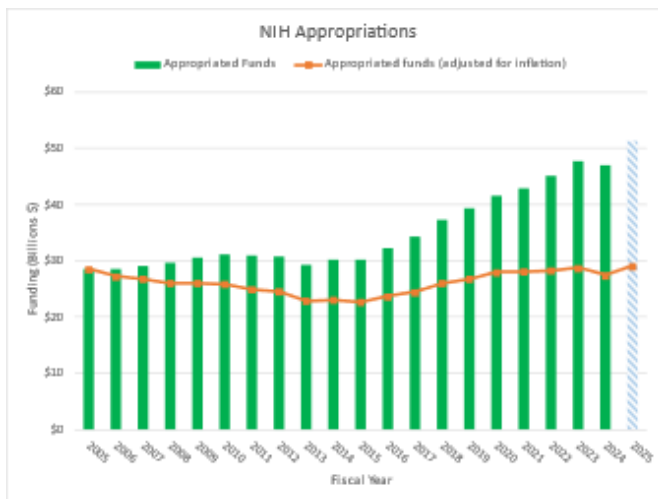
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2023, NIH funded awards totaling **\$12 million** in Wyoming, supporting **265 jobs** and **\$49 million** in economic activity.
- In FY 2023, the biopharmaceutical industry in Wyoming supported **736 jobs** and **234 businesses**.

#### Impact of Cancer in Wyoming<sup>3</sup>

- In 2024, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **3,320** will reside in Wyoming.
- In 2024, an estimated 611,720 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **1,320** residents of Wyoming.

### NIH FUNDING

#### A Strong National Priority<sup>4</sup>



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.22 billion for the NIH in FY 2025.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
